



Code of conduct for parents/carers

ALDERSHOT SNOWSPORTS FOR THE DISABLED

- Ensure the skier/boarder is properly attired for the weather conditions of the time and has wet weather clothing available
- Report any changes or concerns pertaining to the skier's health, in particular breathing or chest conditions, to the instructor/Slope Organiser prior to each session beginning
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of snowsports
- Report any concerns or interventions to either the Club Welfare Officer or an instructor
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials or coaches/instructors.
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination or perceived bullying if witnessed
- Never force the skier/boarder to take part in sport
- Applauding good performances of all
- Never punish or belittle someone for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept officials' judgements
- Support the skier's/boarder's involvement and help them to enjoy snowsports
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour
